Description: The Alaska Democratic Party (ADP) is seeking a field researcher for the 2026 Coordinated Campaign. The Alaska Democratic Party field researcher will be responsible for attending or coordinating volunteers to film and report on in person and remote Republican candidate events and media appearances. They will share details of tracking opportunities on Republican candidates, audio and/or video record events, prepare transcripts on event remarks, and promptly upload audio and/or video to online databases, as well as other research tasks when needed. A successful field researcher will be highly motivated, able to work in a fast-paced environment, demonstrate attention to detail, and possess excellent communication skills.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Monitoring, capturing, and cataloging events, interviews, fundraisers, and other events held or participated in by Republican candidates, including but not limited to the timely production of reports analyzing the events' substance
- Monitoring news clips, blogs, state and county websites, campaign activist websites and other sources in order to find and maintain schedule of tracking opportunities
- Confirming event details, candidate attendance, and getting technology ready for events
- Filming or audio recording each public event
- Preparing memos and uploading footage the same day as the event
- Researching and filming other politically relevant events
- Recruiting volunteers to assist with tracking and training and managing tracking volunteers
- Provide support for Alaska Democratic Party research and communications rapid response and accountability efforts

Required Skills, Abilities, and Experience

- Prior political experience preferred. Experience with non-political research methods will also be considered
- Initiative to work independently and follow through on all projects
- Excellent time management, planning, troubleshooting and communication skills
- Willingness and ability to travel and attend events within Alaska
- Familiarity with video editing is a plus

Compensation and Location

The salary for this role is \$4,500 a month.

Applicants must live in or be willing to relocate to Alaska. Applicants must have the ability to travel throughout the state for up to several days at a time and must have a valid driver's license.
