Primary Responsibilities:

- Build, manage, and execute a comprehensive constituency outreach plan — including community engagement, coalition-building, stakeholder meetings, volunteer activation, relational organizing, and GOTV events;
- Oversee day-to-day outreach operations, including contact tracking, meeting documentation, follow-up with community partners, and support for events;
- Maintain accurate records across all outreach and engagement systems: updating constituency databases, producing internal reports, tracking commitments, and coordinating with other members of the political team;
- Ensure all outreach activities comply with relevant campaign, organizational, and legal guidelines; coordinate with compliance or political leadership to ensure proper documentation and readiness for audits or reporting.

Qualifications:

- Demonstrated experience executing multi-layered outreach, coalition-building, or stakeholder management programs;
- Proficiency in Microsoft Excel/Google Sheets and familiarity with common political organizing CRMs or outreach tools;
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, with strong organization, documentation, and follow-through;
- Proven ability to work independently, manage multiple priorities, and meet tight deadlines in a fast-paced campaign environment.
